Rosa Lee Carroll married Dan Kirkland at Everglades, Florida, in 1908. Dan Kirkland had three brothers that I knew - Noah, Bud and Arthur. There was fifth boy - how - Workland, who died when he was about 19, years old. Mrs. Noah Kirkland, Jessie, is still living in Naples. Mrs. Arthur Kirkland, Susie, died of cancer years ago; and Mrs. Bud Kirkland, Emma, is still living in Naples.

Rosa and Dan had three children - Marie, James and Theodore.

Marie Kirkland married Jesse Smith at Ft. Myers and they have lived at Ft. Myers, Tice, and Naples where they and their family are living now. Marie and Jesse have five children living and they lost at least one child - a little girl. James, Harry, and George are their sons and Nancy Jane and Stella Rose their daughters. Nancy was named for little Grandma, of course, and Stella Rose was named for her Grandma, Rosa, and for me - "Aunt Stella". James married Noah Kirkland's granddaughter, Annabelle Keen, about a year ago and they expect their first child about December, 1955. Harry is expecting to marry Nancy Ranier of Estero in August, 1955. George is Marion's age (he was born on March 17th as was Stella Rose about twelve years later) and is a Junior in highschool this September.

James Kirkland married Maude Nash in Ft. Myers and has lived here and Marco - building a home first one-place and then the other - and is now living here. James and Maude had three Children: Genevieve, a girl Marion's age who left school last year and is now working; Eleanor a couple of years younger; and James Daniel several years younger than Eleanor.

In May 1930 Jesse took his own life over on the east coast by taking poison. After his death Elled spent most of her time on the east coast operating a beauty parlor. She married several times and finally returned to Naples with her husband, where they now live (1955). She did beauty parlor work for years here and Mr. Brooker had a garage. Now they have a home on Gordon Drive "The Sea Gull" where they take guests.

Norman Ernest Carroll married Stella Carlin of Ashland, Wisaonsin, at Ft. Myers, on March 2, 1927. They have two children, James Ernest and Maude Marion. At this writing Marion is a senior in high school and James Ernest is in service at Camp Stewart, Georgia, and his wife, Margie Williams Carroll, and their son, Raymond Ernest (Reccy) are with him in Hinesville, Georgia.



Henry Jackson Carroll married Helen Grant, of Ojus, Florida, in about 1923, and they have two daughters: Lois Fay who married Royal V. Cooley, of Cincinnati, Ohio; and Grace Lucillates who married Meryle Dean Allen of Ojus, Florida. Lois and Royal are living in Hollywood, Florida and have no children (1955); Grace and Meryle live in Ft. Lauderdale and have a son and daughter; Carol, the daughter is the older, and the son is Meryle Dean Jr. (Butchie). About a year after the girls graduated from Highschool, Helen and Henry were divorced. Over a year later Helen married Norman N.
